

March 2009: Arlington Receives \$40,000 Ohio Development Grant for Mansfield Biodiesel Pumps Company to Sell its Own Product at Mansfield Plant Location

In March the State awarded a \$40,000 grant from the Clean Cities program for the installation of a biodiesel dispensing facility at the Company's Mansfield plant on 4th Street. "We appreciate having the State of Ohio invest in Arlington and City of Mansfield." said Arlington Principal Jeff Schultheis.

Arlington started production at its Mansfield plant in 2007, and is planning a major upgrade to the production facility, as well as the addition of retail pumps. The Arlington site will be the first retail biodiesel outlet in Mansfield, and the location is easily accessible from Interstate 30, which is the main east-west route in north central Ohio. Arlington is also applying for grants from the USDA Rural Energy for America Program (REAP), and the Ohio Stimulus program, for the Mansfield production facility upgrade project.

Start-up with the new equipment is targeted for September, and installation of the pumps is expected to be completed at about the same time.
